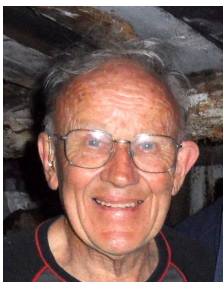
ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING followed by a SPEAKER
