This month our Speaker will be **Bronwyn Wiltshire**, retired High School language teacher, traveller and current leader of the Knox Singers. Her talk is entitled:

She has spent the last 40 years teaching at a number of High schools in the city and at present she is teaching ESOL (English for Speakers of Other Languages) once a week at St Mark's, Avonhead.

Last year Bronwyn and her husband made their third overseas trip in recent years, spending 3 1/2 months visiting all the family and friends from years past, as well as doing some sight-seeing in between. She was fascinated by the various differences she noticed with the passing years and has written about these experiences in a 4 part series for the Knox Life Magazine and will also share them with us.
